Our dedicated team has been hard at work preparing new classrooms, creating a garden, and setting up essential installations. Curriculum development and training will be conducted next months and student classes will be officially launched in January 2025. This program will empower hearing-disabled students, ages 10 to 14, by teaching them valuable cooking and gardening skills, helping to boost their confidence and independence.
